Sparkles the Fire Safety Dog was rescued from a home with 62 dogs.

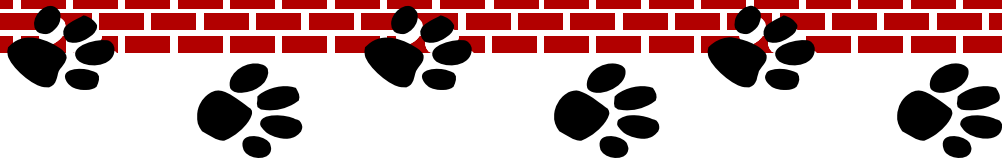
Sparkles gained international attention from her work with her fire safety efforts.

The brick walkway links the official National Fallen Firefighters Monument, honoring all fallen fire heroes, to the historic firefighters chapel as it winds its way through the new National Memorial Park, site of the annual national memorial service.
